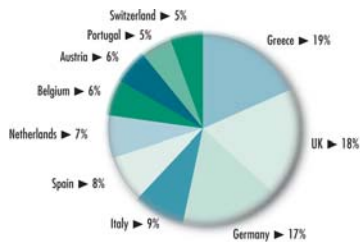
The Association is also involved in various research programmes such as the EPD (European Practice Database), DOPPS, Hepatitis C, and many others.

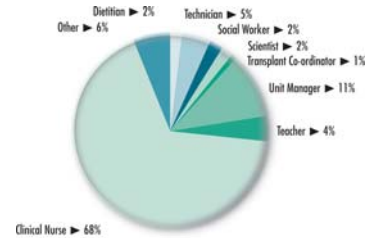

EDTNA/ERCA is the only Association of its kind offering a multidisciplinary collaboration and exchange on a truly European and worldwide level.

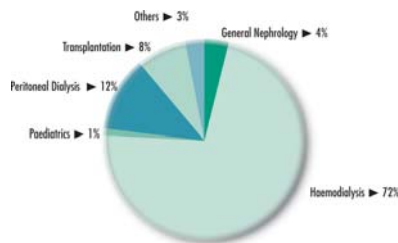
Top Ten Ranking Countries



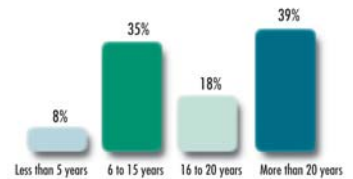
Professional Groups

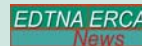
