GENERAL INFORMATION

Accreditation of learning hours

The 53rd EDTNA/ERCA International Conference will be accredited. To ensure maximum quality education and a professional Scientific Programme, EDTNA/ERCA intends to obtain International Continuing Nursing Education Credits (ICNEC) for the International Conference in Porto. The ICNECs are granted by the International Council of Nurses once strict admission conditions are fulfilled. The ICNEC awards provide proof of a high-quality conference. EDTNA/ERCA makes its best effort to render such an opportunity to its delegates and members, so the approval for awarding International Continuing Nursing Education Credits (ICNECs) is currently being sought from the International Council of Nurses. Details of the sessions eligible for accreditation points will be published on the conference website in due time – www.edtnerca.org.

Conference Badges

Each conference delegate will receive a conference badge upon registration. The conference badge must be worn at all times to be able to enter the Scientific Sessions and receive education accreditation. On your badge, there is a QR code that will be scanned when entering and each session hall (if applicable).

Credits will be assigned according to the information received from the QR code system. This information is also used for safety reasons to register participants who actually are in the building in case of emergency. Therefore, it is important you present your badge at each session hall when asked.

EDTNA/ERCA SCIENTIFIC PROGRAMME

The upcoming International EDTNA/ERCA Conference is an eagerly anticipated event for healthcare professionals around the world. 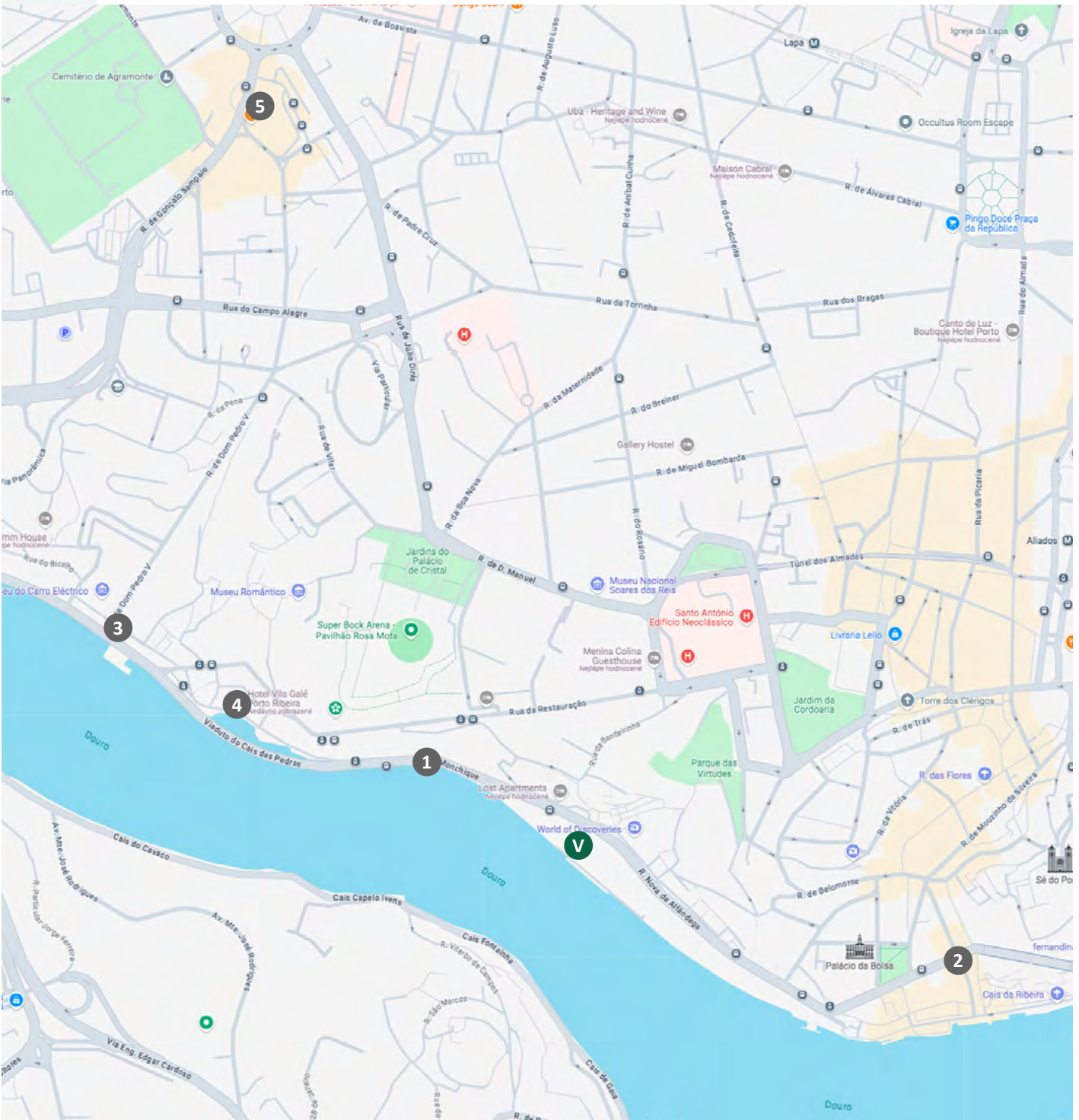

GOOD TO KNOW ABOUT PORTO

WELCOME TO PORTO

Welcome to Porto, one of Portugal's most charming and vibrant cities, known as the gateway to the north and a UNESCO World Heritage site. Porto is rich in history and has long been a hub of culture and commerce. Famous for its iconic Ribeira district, picturesque Douro River, and world-renowned port wine, the city offers a unique blend of historical landmarks and modern charm.

Porto's streets are lined with centuries-old architecture, including the magnificent Clérigos Tower and the stunning Livraria Lello, often cited as one of the most beautiful bookstores in the world. Its thriving arts scene and burgeoning culinary delights, paired with its friendly and welcoming locals, make it a must-visit destination for travelers from around the globe.

Situated in northern Portugal, Porto enjoys a mild Atlantic climate, making it an ideal year-round destination. The city's combination of ancient history, lively modern atmosphere, and breathtaking coastal views make it an exceptional location for both cultural exploration and business events.

Porto's strategic location along the Douro River and its connections to the wine-growing Douro Valley make it a top destination for those interested in gastronomy, wine, and history. Whether you're strolling through its narrow streets, visiting historic sites, or enjoying the vibrant local markets, Porto is a city that invites discovery at every turn.

HOW TO GET HERE – VERY EASILY

BY PLANE

Porto International Airport is connected to 120 domestic and international destinations with 36 airlines. From the airport it will take you approximately 30-45 minutes to get to the city centre.

Francisco Sá Carneiro Porto Airport (OPO) – City Center

Metro

The most affordable way to get from the airport to the city centre is by metro. From the airport you can take metro line E (purple), and it will take you to the city centre within 30 minutes. The price of a one-way ticket is 2,25 EUR

Bus

Local buses (lines 601, 602, and 604) connect the airport and various areas of the city centre. Please note that taking the bus will take you longer than taking the metro, as it stops more often.

Taxi

Taxis are available outside of the airport. A ride to the city centre should cost approximately 30 EUR.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Public transport in Porto is affordable, reliable and covers most of the city. Tickets are valid for all means of transport, and the prices of the trips vary according to the number of zones you cross.

The [Andante Card](#) is a non-personalized, rechargeable ticket that allows you to travel on the entire public transportation network in the Porto Metropolitan area. It is valid for use of the metro, bus, and local trains. The price you pay depends on the journey you make, and not on the mode of transport you use or the number of boardings you make. It's simple, practical and affordable.

Please note: You must validate your ticket when you start a journey. On trains and in the metro, use the existing validators in the stations. On buses, use the validators at the entrance of the vehicle.

If you plan to purchase the [Porto Card](#) for your stay in the city, we recommend that you buy it online beforehand or immediately at the airport, as it includes transportation to and from the airport. The Porto Card is the city's tourist card. With it, you can benefit from discounted or free access to various cultural sites and museums. The card can be purchased for 1–4 days.
