From the 11<sup>th</sup> until the 14<sup>th</sup> of November 2021 I attend to the XLVI virtual national congress of SEDEN (Sociedad Española De Enfermería Nefrológica) as a representant of EDTNA/ERCA. The title of this year was “walking together towards common objectives”. The congress had a virtual format and there were oral communications, conferences, round tables, symposiums, posters communications, workshops and commercial stands.

Most of the sessions were live and others were recorded and there was a time to ask questions to the authors. All sessions were recorded in order to be able to listen to them within the following 24 hours.

The inaugural conference topic was “Euthanasia before palliative care?”. Other topics that were of relevant interest were: vascular access, where up to date data was presented in order to assess the best needling practice as well as fistula assessment. Moreover, physical exercise, nutrition, sex as well as transplanted patients and nursing management in a hemodialysis unit.

Workshops were focused on vascular echography, research methodology and the use of bioimpedance markers.

The closing conference was “COVID-19 vaccination. Past, present and future”.

All participants were national (Spanish) and the language of all conference was Spanish.
