

11th Chiemgau-Seminar – Nephrological professional groups in dialog

From 3rd - 4th November 2018 the 11th Chiemgau-Seminar took place in St. Ruppert Traunstein. It was organized by Thomas Fernsebner and his team from the nephrological educational institute Traunstein.

First day we had a bar camp. Fore groups discussed different topics like ethic at the end of life in CKD care, skill mix, nurses-patient-ratio. In the plenum the groups presented their thoughts for discussion.

At the end of the session it was a great pleasure for me to hand over the certificate for the recertification of the educational institute in the name of John Sedgwick to Thomas Fernsebner (see picture).

Latterly Thomas showed us the historical planetarium and told us a lot of the old building of St. Ruppert.

The second day started with a session about the state of the art of therapeutically options in peritonitis, presented by Prof. Haag-Weber from Straubing. We heard a lot of interesting lectures about ultrasound guides cannulation, by Frau Spindler and hygiene in dialysis, KRINKO-recommendations, as well as blood pressure measurement and interpretation of results by Prof. Böger.

In between I took the opportunity to talk about EDTNA/ERCA and its aims to participants. I invited them to come to Konstanz to the three-country congress in November and to our next conference in Prague 2019.
