

Insights from Turkey's EDTNA/ERCA Brand Ambassador at the 35th National Nephrology Nursing Congress

Held in Antalya from November 12–16, 2025, the 35th National Nephrology Nursing Congress served as an important scientific platform where current approaches, research, innovative clinical practices, and national and international professional collaborations in nephrology nursing were discussed.

Assoc. Prof. Dr. Eylem Topbaş participated in the congress as an invited speaker, session chair, scientific committee member, and educator in various workshops. Additionally, as Turkey's representative for the European Dialysis and Transplant Nurses Association / European Renal Care Association (EDTNA/ERCA), she shared with participants the association's activities, accreditation processes, current projects, strategic goals, and the professional benefits of membership during the closing session.

Information was provided on the advantages of becoming a member, how to complete the membership process, and how to access post-membership educational and publication resources. As part of the presentation, a special video message from EDTNA/ERCA President Anastasia Liossatu, prepared specifically for the congress, was also shared with the participants.



As part of the translation project she led as Turkey's representative, the books that colleagues had voted for the most in the previous year and requested to be translated into Turkish were successfully completed and presented to the congress participants. Dr. Topbaş expressed her gratitude to DAVIVA Dialysis Services and the Turkish Nephrology, Dialysis, and Transplantation Nurses Association for their support in bringing the project to life. She also thanked Dr. Ebru Baę, who co-edited the translations of the 1st and 3rd books, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Nurten Özen, who co-edited the 2nd book, and the authors who contributed to the translation of the 2nd book. During the national congress, the books were distributed to association members in electronic format via USB drives.





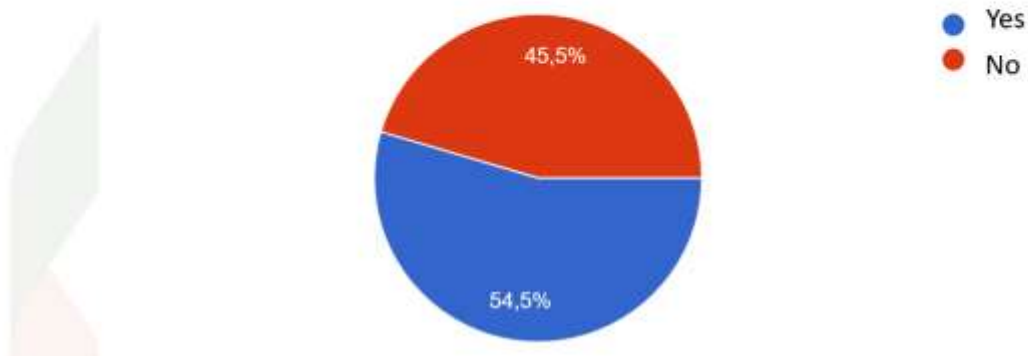

EDTNA/ERCA Turkey Engagement Survey – 2025 Findings

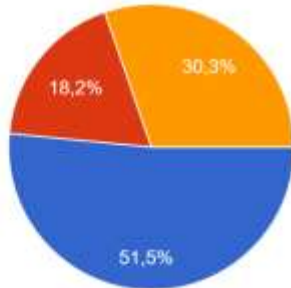


1. Had you been familiar with the European Dialysis and Transplant Nurses Association (EDTNA/ERCA) prior to attending the congress?

- I need more information in order to benefit from the membership.

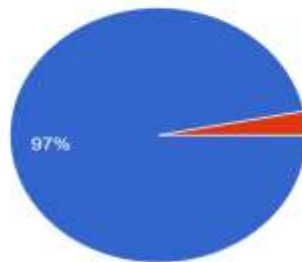
