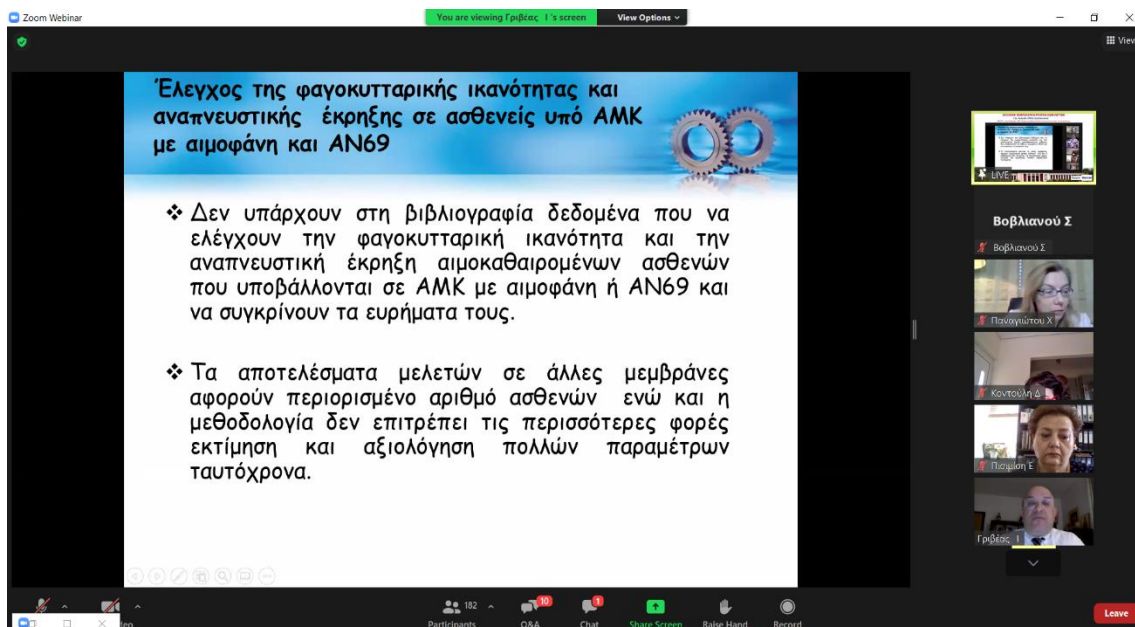


## 32<sup>nd</sup> Annual Scientific Meeting of HENNA

**Presentation and Outcomes of Patients with End-Stage Kidney Disease and COVID-19**

**METHODS**

- 59 patients with ESKD: 57 patients on HD, 2 patients on PD
- Median age = 63 years, 56% male, 75% Hispanic/Latino ethnicity, 80% access AV/F AVG

**OUTCOMES**

- Symptoms: fever (49%), cough (39%), dyspnea (36%)
- Deaths: 31% → median 6 days (IQR 4-14) after hospitalization
- Discharge: 69% → median 8 days (IQR 6-12) after hospitalization
- Patients who died: older age and higher admission WBC and CRP

**CONCLUSION:** COVID-19 was associated with high mortality in patients with ESKD on dialysis. Higher levels of inflammatory markers were associated with severe disease.
